



2010 WISCONSIN REBATES for Energy-Efficient Appliances using Natural Gas

TALK TO YOUR DEALER ABOUT QUALIFYING MODELS BEFORE PURCHASING.

Talk to your dealer about submitting rebate applications to Focus on Energy.

Furnaces - \$200 - \$350

Be sure to ask your dealer about a federal tax credit also.

Boilers - \$200 - \$600

Be sure to ask your dealer about a federal tax credit also.

Water Heaters - \$200 - \$300 for natural gas water heaters

There are several choices for water heaters. Your rebate may be even higher. Talk to your dealer about options.

Solar Hot Water Systems - \$2,000

All facets of your system choice, purchase and installation must be Focus on Energy approved.

Clothes Washers - \$100

If your washer is more than 10 years old, a replacement could save you \$135 per year on utility bills.

Dishwashers - \$25

If your dishwasher is more than 15 years old, it may cost twice as much to operate (\$66 vs. \$35 per year) as a new high efficiency model.

Refrigerators/Freezers - \$75/\$50

A new refrigerator costs about \$60 - \$70 less per year to operate, compared to models made before 1999. A new freezer costs about \$35 less per year to operate.

Must be purchased after January 1, 2010. Residential customers only; landlords and commercial businesses are not eligible.

If your dealer asks, you can confirm that St. Croix Valley Natural Gas is a participating utility for Focus on Energy rebates for natural gas appliances.
