**Before you dig, call 811
 It's the law!**



Planning a project with some digging involved? Call 811 three business days before you dig. It's the law! And by calling 811 you will request that your underground utilities be located and marked.

When you dig within 18 inches of a marked utility, use care! Use a shovel and dig carefully.

If you accidentally scrape or gouge our pipe, call us right away. We will repair it for FREE.

If you hit our pipe, and create a gas leak, no matter how small, call 911 immediately. Even tiny gas leaks can be dangerous. We are sorry, we must charge you to fix the leak, but it will keep you and your neighbors safe from gas migration through your foundation and into your home. Mending it yourself is a risk you don't want to take.

Locate Marking Color Codes:

- Red - Electric
- Orange - Communications, Telephone/CATV
- Blue - Potable Water
- Green - Sewer/Drainage
- Yellow - Gas/Petroleum Pipe Line
- Purple - Reclaimed Water
