**Leak Detection Surveys throughout the Summer**

Our mobile leak detector vehicle checks for natural gas leaks along our pipelines on road easements next to highways and roads.

This fulfills our duty under the federal and state pipeline safety codes to monitor for underground leaks.

Underground leaks can be caused by gophers chewing on plastic pipe, by lightning strikes melting the locating wires next to the pipe, and displacement by impact from excavators, among other causes.

These mobile leak detectors check roadways every three years.

In town, handheld devices are used to check pipelines annually or every three years, depending on the type of location.
